Mi Día from Scratch:

For Father's Day at the Plano location, chef Gabriel DeLeon will offer three pairings of food and margaritas that highlight his three main culinary influences: Tex-Mex and the cuisines of Mexico City and Santa Fe. The Mexican pairing will include a pork shank rubbed with achiote paste and roasted in a banana leaf served with a margarita made with El Mayor tequila añejo, Grand Marnier, lemon juice and agave nectar. The three pairings are \$34 to \$40 each. The restaurant's regular brunch and dinner menus will also be available.
