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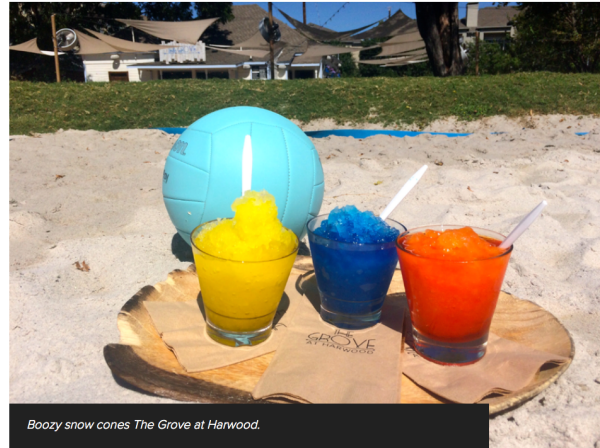
Treat yourself to these boozy frozen delights available in D-FW this summer

The backyard bar located near Uptown and Downtown Dallas offers a myriad of flavors like passion fruit and watermelon, which patrons can mix and match with their preferred flavor of vodka. The bar also offers house combinations, such as the Drunken Smurf, a blue raspberry snowball with berry vodka, and the Mango Madness, a mango snowball with mango vodka.
